FIRE EXTINGUISHER, HYDRANT AND HOSE REEL YEALY SERVICE FOR A PERIOD OF 36 MONTHS

1. <u>INTRODUCTION</u>

DBSA Facilities Management wishes to outsource the provision of services to an external party that will ensure that all Fire Extinguishers are serviced, to a desirable standard that is in line with the industry practice and safety requirements

2. PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- To appoint service providers to assist with evaluating responsiveness, technical evaluations and price and preference evaluations for 5 provinces.
- To provide weekly status update, on progress and issues encountered

3. SCOPE OF WORK

3.1 The Service Provider Shall carry out a complete Yearly Service of following DBSA fire equipment:

- 49 by 2kg Co2
- 29 by 4.5Kg DCP STP
- 28 by 5Kg Co2
- 204 by 9Kg DCP STP
- 66 Fire hydrants
- 73 by 30m Fire Hose Reel
- 8 Evacuation Trolleys
- Supply 2 by 4.5KG DCP STP
- Supply 2 by 5KG Co2
- Supply five 1.8m by 1.8m fire blanket.

3.2 The total number of fire extinguisher is 310, hydrants 66 and hose reel 73.

3.3 The following checks and duties will be performed yearly:

- Fire extinguisher Annual Inspection and maintenance
- Provide each extinguisher with a sign indicating it has been examined and the following information must be visible on the service labels date of current and due service date.
- Provide test certificates and records to be retained on board for inspection
- Renew charges for portable fire extinguishers if there's any indication of deterioration in the contents or loss of pressure.

- Recharge or renew CO2 extinguishers if the gas loss by weight exceeds 10% of the original weight.
- All fire extinguishers are checked for proper location, charging pressure and conditions.
- Water hydrant and Hose Reel Annual Inspection and maintenance.
- All hydrants are tested for operation (Valve Seals)
- All fire hoses are hydrostatically tested (Nozzles and Valve seals).
- The fire hose reel shall have two service labels one on the outside of the front reel disc and one label in a position that is visible once the hose reel is fully unwound.
- Provide each hydrant and Hose reel with a sign indicating it has been examined.
- Test and provide yearly compliance certification as per OHS regulations
