- b. ALL BIDS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON THE OFFICIAL FORMS PROVIDED- (NOT TO BE RETYPED) OR ONLINE
- c. BIDDERS MUST REGISTER ON THE CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE (CSD) TO UPLOAD MANDATORY INFORMATION NAMELY: (BUSINESS REGISTRATION/ DIRECTORSHIP/ MEMBERSHIP/IDENTITY NUMBERS; TAX COMPLIANCE STATUS; AND BANKING INFORMATION FOR VERIFICATION PURPOSES). TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR ESTABLISHING A DBSA INFRASTRUCTURE RESEARCH CHAIR AT A SOUTH AFRICAN UNIVERSITY

1. Introduction

These terms of reference (ToRs) are for procuring the services of a tertiary institution to provide services on a partly planned and partly responsive basis through an Infrastructure Research Chair platform.

2. Background

The role of DFIs like the DBSA is very central to the growth and development of the country especially in relation to the development, operation, and maintenance of infrastructure. One central characteristic of DFIs is their ability to play a countercyclical role and to have the agility to be developmental on the one hand as well as responsive to crises. It is very important for the Bank to be able to balance sustainability as all DFIs should. Equally critical is the need to deepen the developmental impact of its work. It is these characteristics that enable DFIs to be relevant and have the appropriate impact in the respective sectors they are involved in.

It is also important for there to be a discernible link between the Bank's projects and contribution to the sustainable development principles embodied in the various national and transnational strategic documents like the NDP and the SDGs as cases in point, including advancing regional as well as continental integration. It is for these reasons that the DBSA seeks to establish an Infrastructure Research Chair at a University and keep ahead of developments through research and conversation.

3. Objectives of the Research Chair

- a) To develop two (2) annually planned and short infrastructure research papers on topics determined by the DBSA across the infrastructure development value chain.
- b) To develop one (1) in-depth and long infrastructure paper on emerging issues in the infrastructure development value chain.
- c) To provide peer review on up to eight (8) internal DBSA research papers over a twelve-month period.

4. Scope of Work

4.1 Content Detail

The contents of the assignments will consist of the following sectors as guided by the Bank's mandated infrastructure development sectors:

Primary sectors

- Information and Communications Technology (ICT)
- Water and Sanitation
- Transport
- Energy

Secondary sectors

- Education
- Health
- Human Settlements

The infrastructure development value chain entails planning, preparing, financing, building, and maintaining infrastructure projects. That is why key economic, regulatory, political, financial, governance or social trends that affect the development of infrastructure in the mandated sectors may also receive research attention.

The tertiary institution will be expected to have extensive networks in the infrastructure environment as well as the necessary technical expertise to undertake the commissioned research assignments. It is imperative to note that the tertiary institution will be required to sign a non-disclosure agreement for the project information that will be supplied to it.

4.2 Expertise required

The assignment requires expertise in research, report writing as well as presentation skills on infrastructure, DFIs, the economies of South Africa, the SADC region and the continent.

Expertise required to successfully prepare the reports inter alia are:

- a. Demonstrated ability to prepare comprehensive analyses of the infrastructure sector, gaps, and opportunities in development finance
- b. Capability to outline policy frameworks in the various Bank mandated sectors
- c. Capability to propose options for development of the various Bank mandated sectors
- d. Expertise to undertake analysis of other partners in the Bank mandated sectors, and
- e. Ability to apply insights from the above to outline the impact on the Bank.

Deliverables

Various reports that respond to the assigned topics to be delivered to time and quality specifications.

Tender Evaluation & Adjudication Criteria

Tertiary institutions must provide a fixed price for twelve-month period.

Supporting documents will also have to be provided for company experience, local, regional, and continental infrastructure, and related research experience.
