- 1.2. ALL BIDS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON THE OFFICIAL FORMS PROVIDED- (NOT TO BE RE-TYPED) OR ONLINE
- 1.3. BIDDERS MUST REGISTER ON THE CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE (CSD) TO UPLOAD MANDATORY INFORMATION NAMELY: (BUSINESS REGISTRATION/ DIRECTORSHIP/ MEMBERSHIP/IDENTITY NUMBERS; TAX COMPLIANCE STATUS; AND BANKING INFORMATION FOR VERIFICATION PURPOSES). - 1.13. THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER WILL BE THE BIDDER THAT SCORES THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF POINTS IN THE PRICE AND PREFERENCE EVALUATION, UNLESS THE DBSA EXERCISES ITS RIGHT TO CANCEL THE RFP, IN LINE WITH THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS, 2017.



#### 1.14. ALL PRICES MUST BE QUOTED IN SOUTH AFRICAN RAND (ZAR)

- 1.15. THE COST OF MARKETING AND ADVERTISING, AND OTHER CHARGES MUST BE INCLUDED IN THE TOTAL PRICE QUOTED, IF THESE ITEMS ARE REQUESTED AS PART OF THE DBSA COST TEMPLATE / MODEL OF THIS RFQ. #### TERMS OF REFERENCE AND PROJECT SPECIFIC BRIEF

**PROJECT TITLE: SAKHUMZI FUND** 

#### 1. BACKGROUND

- a) In line with the DBSA's SMME funding initiative as undertaken in the bank's current corporate plan, the Bank in consultation with NEF undertook to establish an SMME fund to be known as the the Sakhumzi Fund (the "Fund"). The focus of the proposed fund will be to provide funding to black-owned and managed Small, Medium and Micro Enterprises ("SMMEs"), under the current challenging socioeconomic environment, including SMMEs operating within the value chain of the industries that are serviced under the DBSA mandate, as well as township and rural economies.
- b) The Bank is subject to PFMA regulations.
- c) The Bank uses IFRS reporting framework.
- d) The sections of the Company's Act applicable to the Bank are section 27 to 31.
- e) The Bank is exempt from Income tax however it is subject to and complies with all other South African taxes, including employees' tax and value added tax.

#### 2. PROBLEM STATEMENT

- The creation of the fund affords the DBSA an opportunity to increase exposure and support to SMME's.
- By its nature, the accounting and taxation treatment relating to private equity and fund of fund investments is highly complex and is highly sensitive to the ever-evolving environment (both macro-economic and operational) within which the relevant entity operates.
- Accordingly, the accounting and taxation opinion should encompass the underlying principles as prescribed by IFRS and South African Income tax legislation, in order to ensure that an impeccable solution is provided in the best interest of the DBSA, and as such the accounting and taxation advise should be provided by professionals with adequate technical expertise and experience in private equity and fund of fund investments.
- It is important to get the right technical expertise in order to minimise the risk of poor decision-making as the advice derived will provide input into the DBSA's key decision-making committees and will have a significant medium to long term impact on the DBSA's strategic imperatives.



#### 3. SCOPE OF WORK

- To provide a technical accounting and taxation opinion on the application of financial reporting principles and taxation implications for the Sakhumzi Fund, involving facts and circumstances specifically to the Bank.
- The accounting opinion should be based on International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) as issued by the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB).
- The tax opinion should consider South African taxation laws.

#### 4. EXPECTED DELIVERABLES

#### 5. COMPETENCY AND EXPERTISE REQUIREMENTS

Qualifying criteria for the project include:

- Service provider with extensive experience (both company and individuals) in an advisory role that encompass accounting and taxation opinions relating to the creation of funds, including experience in advising banking and financial services clients in respect of Private Equity and Fund of Fund Investments and PFMA requirements (at least 15 years' experience for Company and senior team members assigned to this project).
- Senior staff members allocated to the project should have appropriate qualifications such as CA (SA)/CFA and have extensive expertise / expert knowledge on, Taxation, IFRS, Private Equity and Fund of Fund Investments
- Track record in undertaking similar assignments (i.e. accounting and taxation opinions Private Equity and Fund of Fund Investments) in the past 15 years by the senior team members.

- 4. Each person whose signature appears on the accompanying bid has been authorized by the bidder to determine the terms of, and to sign the bid, on behalf of the bidder;
- 5. For the purposes of this Certificate and the accompanying bid, I understand that the word "competitor" shall include any individual or organization, other than the bidder, whether or not affiliated with the bidder, who:

- 7. In particular, without limiting the generality of paragraphs 6 above, there has been no consultation, communication, agreement or arrangement with any competitor regarding:
  - (a) prices:
  - (b) geographical area where product or service will be rendered (market allocation)
  - (c) methods, factors or formulas used to calculate prices;
  - (d) the intention or decision to submit or not to submit, a bid;
  - (e) the submission of a bid which does not meet the specifications and conditions of the bid; or
  - (f) bidding with the intention not to win the bid.
- 8. In addition, there have been no consultations, communications, agreements or arrangements with any competitor regarding the quality, quantity, specifications and conditions or delivery particulars of the products or services to which this bid invitation relates.
- 9. The terms of the accompanying bid have not been, and will not be, disclosed by the bidder, directly or indirectly, to any competitor, prior to the date and time of the official bid opening or of the awarding of the contract.
- <sup>3</sup> Joint venture or Consortium means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skill and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract.
