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Appointment of a Governance Transaction Adviser to support the "Independent Power Producers' Office" (IPP Office) for the Battery Energy Storage Independent Power Producers Procurement Programme (ESIPPPP)for a period of 24 Months

1. INTRODUCTION

The IPP Office (IPPO) is mandated to undertake the procurement of energy on behalf of the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE). As such it is the IPPO's responsibility to prepare procurement documentation and ran the procurement processes to ultimately select and appoint successful bidders. These bidders (independent power producers [IPP]) are responsible to construct, operate and maintain independent power plants providing much needed power to the South African grid.

2. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE

1.1 In order to meet the requirement to procure 513MW of additional capacity from Energy Storage within the tight timelines as set out in the Determination, the IPPO as mandated by the DMRE will release the Energy Storage Independent Power Producer Procurement Programme (ESIPPPP) Request for Proposal (RFP). The key requirement of an ESIPPPP will be to procure energy storage capacity from energy storage technologies with short lead times to be available.

In view of the above, there is a requirement to appoint a team of Transaction Advisers to:

- a. The Evaluation of the Bids Submitted and
- b. All activities associated with Commercial and Financial close.
- 1.2 As in all previous IPP Programmes, the evaluation of bids will be undertaken by an external, independent team of experts representing all required disciplines with a governance expert overseeing and monitoring the evaluation process and procedures. As part of this TOR a team of multi-disciplinary, independent evaluators to design and undertake the Evaluation of Bids, appointment of Preferred Bidders and all Financial Close activities associated with the ESIPPPP in response to the Request for Proposals (RFP) issued, will be selected.
- 1.3 The purpose of this ToR is to set out the requirements to obtain the services of skilled and experienced Transaction Advisors to assist with the **Governance function** in the evaluation of bids to ensure a fair, transparent and competitive outcome to the RFP.

3 THE EVALUATION TEAM

In view of the above, the team of appointed Transaction Advisers selected to undertake and support IPP Office in the Evaluation and Financial Close processes will consist of:

- Legal Advisers;
- Economic Advisers;
- Financial Advisers;
- Technical Advisers; and
- Governance experts.

The basis for the evaluation will be the RFP, the Evaluation Manual and accompanying Evaluation Templates as approved by the Department.

In managing potential conflict of interest and also in lieu of a potential high number of bid responses, the Transactional Advisors will have to declare and indicate how they will manage potential conflict of interest.

4. SCOPE OF WORK

Find below the scope of work for the Governance Advisers:

- Undertake the governance compliance review of the evaluation process in respect of the Bid Submission Phase, in compliance with the Evaluation Manual and the Bid Management Guide to maintain transparency, equity and fairness during both the tender receiving and the evaluation processes.
- Observe the evaluation process of Bid Responses, including the registration and delivery of Bid Responses, and assist in the identification of areas of non-compliance.
- The Governance team should be involved in the following processes:
 - Facilities and Processes Assessment of compliance and monitoring to maintain transparency during both the tender receiving and the evaluation processes.

- Evaluation review Provide real time review on site. Observation of the bid receiving and registration process as well as attending all meetings held on site related to the evaluation process.
- Bid Clarification The team will follow the process relating to Bid Clarification to ensure that Clarifications are consistent, fair and transparent.
- Part C Evaluation and BAC reporting The Governance team will observe all discussions related to the outcome of preferred bidder recommendations to the BAC. The BAC reports will also be reviewed to provide assurance that the intent of the meetings and discussions have been translated to the final recommendations.
- Identify and highlight during the period of the evaluation, to the nominated officials, potential noncompliance as identified, together with suggestions for mitigation, to enable changes to be made as appropriate to the processes during the evaluation period.
- The Governance team will provide a status report to the IPP Office management team coveringall
 relevant processes, procedures to confirm compliance and if so required highlight any potential noncompliance with appropriate remedial action.
- The Governance team will issue a report to summarise the findings related to governance compliance during the evaluation period. The report should include inter alia confirmation that the bid evaluation procedures were followed and set out the mitigating actions taken in respect of any incidences of noncompliance. This report should also include recommendations for improvements in the process for future phases to reduce instances of potential for non-compliance as well as providing a review of the effectiveness of the compliance and adherence to the recommendations made during the previous phases.
- Preparing detailed responses to any questions from the BAC or from IPPO management.

5. APPROACH TO PROCUREMENT

The DBSA, with this Terms of Reference, is inviting Transaction Advisers to provide their resourcesand pricing in terms of the aforementioned Scope of Work.

Any firm of advisors advising the DMRE will be allowed to advise private sector and/or the lenders in the procurement process, provided that the same individuals from firms advising the DMRE on the Programme will not be used by such firms when advising private sector and/or the lenders.

Therefore, a firm participating in this tender should provide the DMRE with its policy to manage potential conflict of interest that may arise from such firm of advisors that are advising both the DMRE and Bidders.

This policy should include the measures that will be put in place and applied to manage such conflict of interest.

The Evaluation Team will have to sign Declaration of Interest and Confidentiality Undertakings.

6. DELIVERABLES, TIMELINES, PAYMENT TERMS AND MILESTONES

In responding to this TOR, the Transaction Advisors are required to provide a separate or distinct fee proposal for each of the functions specified in the scope of work.

Please note the following guidelines in respect of the fee proposal:

- The fee proposal should cover the requirements as outlined in this ToR for the Evaluation phase.
- The pricing element of the bid should be a fixed fee inclusive of VAT and disbursements.
- The fixed fee should be broken down in cost per deliverable/milestone. Refer to the table included for the payment milestones that are also reflecting the associated weight in terms of pricing.
- Ensure that the fee proposal cover all elements as detailed in the scope of work. The detailed scope should be summarized in the payment milestones referred to under previous bullet.

Work will commence as soon as the appointment is finalized and a purchase order is issued. Nowork is to be undertaken without a duly authorized purchase order issued by the IPP Office.

Service Providers are required to consider the time allocated for each section under this ToR and ensure that sufficient and key staff is available for the whole period of the assignment.

Please note that the Evaluation will take place in the secure evaluation center at the IPPO buildingcomplex.

The Department and IPPO reserve the right to either cancel or replace a deliverable with another as circumstances require or to move the timelines as may be required.
