

RFQ059/2026: Written Responses to Clarification Questions Received

1. **Question:** Would it be possible to provide an indication of the anticipated sample size for the national survey, as well as the expected number of survey questions to be administered to respondents? These details are important for budgeting purposes and will greatly assist in developing accurate cost estimates.
2. **Response:** The survey sample size should be statistically representative of the South African population, based on the sampling methodology proposed by the bidder. For reference, the previous survey included approximately 3,000 respondents.

Bidders may use this as a basis for costing purposes; however, the questionnaire for the current assignment may be refined and could be slightly longer than the previous version.

Bidders are therefore expected to propose and justify an appropriate sampling approach, sample size, and survey instrument that best meets the objectives of the Terms of Reference, with the associated costs reflected in their financial proposals.
